HYDRA-LAST

GENERAL INFORMATION: **HYDRA-LAST** is a non-ionic, long-term soil surfactant designed to resist microbial degradation in the soil. **HYDRA-LAST** is designed to ensure uniform moisture characteristics and reduce LDS for a period of up to 120 days. **HYDRA-LAST** has a high level of turf safety, even if the product is not immediately watered-in.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply at the beginning of the season or prior to expected hydrophobic conditions. Apply in split applications of 8 ounces per 1,000 square feet. Apply second 8-ounce application two weeks after initial application. Apply in 2 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet or water-in for best results.

Tank Mixing: **HYDRA-LAST** may be tank mixed with other commonly used turf chemicals and fertilizers. If applicator is unfamiliar with the performance of this product in tank mixes under user's growing conditions, **HYDRA-LAST** should be tested prior to large-scale application. The applicator should always exercise judgment and caution when using this and all other turf products. Always conduct a jar test when tank mixing **HYDRA-LAST** with other inputs when the compatibility is unknown.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. **Personal Protective Equipment:** Wear chemical resistant gloves, long-sleeved shirt and long pants, and shoes plus socks.

FIRST AID: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. **If Swallowed:** Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on Skin or Clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. **If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferable mouth to mouth if possible. **If in Eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently

with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue to rinse eyes.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not add anything to the container. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best method of disposing containers if allowed by law. The Agriculture Recycling Container Counsel (ACRC) operates the national recycling center program. Decontaminated containers and materials must be disposed of in a manner allowed by local, state and federal laws and regulations
